

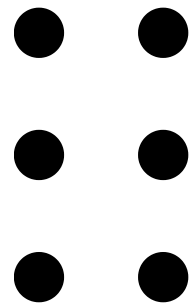

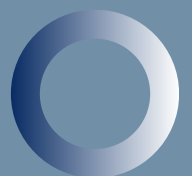
COURSE DIRECTOR
